5 PLANNING SCHEDULE (Appendix 1)

The following planning applications were considered.

 23/02641/HOUSE Ashenberry, Enborne Street, Enborne, Newbury RG20 0JP. SECTION 73 - Vary condition 2 (approved plans) of approved application 23/00366/HOUSE: Erection of new garage via existing access.

Parish Council agreed to no objections.

23/02751/OOD Out Of District Planning Consultation, Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council Pet
Cremation Services, Yew Tree Farm, Hatt Common, East Woodhay, Newbury. Out of District Planning
Consultation BDBC: Ref 23/02920/FUL - Extension of Newbury Pet Crematorium to include an adjoining
store/warehouse, the addition of a lean-to, the siting of a storage container, and the installation of an
additional cremator and associated flue.

Parish Council agreed to no objections.

 23/02596/FULMAJ Longcopse Farm, Vanners Lane, Enborne, Newbury RG20 0LD. Use of land for the siting of up to 24 travelling show persons plots

After a long discussion, it was agreed that Parish Council strongly object, 4 members objected and 1 abstention, due to a declaration of interest.

Policy TS2 should be disregarded as the evidence which informed the policy is out of date and superseded by new evidence which shows no need for new plots for Travelling Showpeople in the district.

This proposal will cause harm to the rural character of the area, the landscape setting, and adjacent ancient woodland and habitats. Highways safety will be further compromised by the increased vehicle movements on Wheatlands Lane, which is single track road in parts. The proposal will result in the loss of agricultural land.

Should the council choose to apply policy TS2, the proposals will still not comply as they fail to show how the plots will only be used by Travelling Showpeople - a fundamental reason for and requirement of the policy. Important aspects of TS2, such as landscape buffers, have not been included in the site boundary.

The site has a history of planning transgressions which remain unresolved. The site has also been associated with serious environmental pollution which it is feared will continue and worsen if these proposals are granted planning permission.

It was also noted that if parishioners write to Enborne District Councillors regarding this planning application it would help support parish council's objection. A letter will be considered to our MP Laura Farris.

• <u>23/02884/CERTE</u> Vanners Farm, Vanners Lane, Enborne, Newbury RG20 0LB. External alteration works to house.

The precept for 2024-2025 was agreed at £10,000. This is a contribution of £26.08 per year for a band D household towards the Parish Council contribution.

8 NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN (NDP)

A public consultation was held on 23/01 which received a good turnout of around 70 parishioners. The feedback was positive from the parish. A presentation was delivered on the history of Enborne. Some of the following points were covered.

- National Planning Policy (NPPF) Paragraph 30: states:
 - 'Once a neighbourhood plan has been brought into force, the policies it contains take precedence over existing non-strategic policies in a local plan covering the neighbourhood area, where they are in conflict; unless they are superseded by strategic or non-strategic policies that are adopted subsequently.'
- Enborne NDP process is in its early stages.
- Evidence needs to be gathered on what the parish needs and wants.
- Allocating development sites in a NDP can stop development happening where we do not want it.
- The parish need to value how much housing is needed in the parish and affordable housing
- Focus groups are being considered to look at draft policies.
- A grant has been applied for towards some of the funding of the early stages of the NDP.
