#### 7. PLANNING APPLICATIONS

  - 24/00344/FUL Cowleaze Farm, Enborne Street, Enborne, Newbury RG20 0JP. Demolition and part demolition of existing barns, the conversion of existing buildings to provide two dwellings, garaging, and ancillary residential accommodation, together with associated external works and landscaping.

• 23/02596/FULMAJ Longcopse Farm, Vanners Lane, Enborne, Newbury. Use of land for the siting of up to 24 travelling showpersons plots.   - 23/02110/HOUSE Crockham House, Church Lane, Crockham Heath RG20 0JY. Extensions to Crockham House; and the removal of the existing garage and stable and the construction of a new garage. WBC approved.
  - <u>24/00363/HOUSE</u> Round Oaks, Enborne Row, Wash Water, Newbury RG20 0LX. Single storey kitchen extension. WBC approved.

## 8. WEST BERKSHIRE COUNCIL LOCAL PLAN 2022-39, POLICY RSA25

<u>23/02596/FULMAJ</u> Longcopse Farm, Vanners Lane, Enborne, Newbury. Use of land for the siting of up to 24 travelling showpersons plots.

A survey had been circulated by the Neighbourhood Development Plan and Parish Council members to Enborne residents to alert them to this planning application. 60 residents signed the petition with an objection. Parish Councillors received confirmation from the inspector that they could attend and speak at the Hearing for RSA25, Matter 10 on 11/06 to raise their objections at the Hearing

## 9. NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN (NDP)

It was recently found that the planning consultant who is advising NDP on legal advice is also advising the developer that is promoting development north of the Enborne charity field. Cllr. Tompkins had spoken to Bell Cornwall, the advisers, regarding this matter. It was felt this was a declaration of interest. This will be an agenda item for the next NDP meeting, Parish Council will be updated once a decision is made if to continue with Bell Cornwall.

#### 10. WATERMILL BRIDGE

No further reports received from Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council regarding the Judicial Review of the appeal process and decision.

#### 11. ENFORCEMENT CASE REF. 23/00525/15UNAU, THE PADDOCKS COTTAGE, ENBORNE

Cllr. Dennis Benneyworth, ward member, said he would investigate this complaint on behalf of Parish Council. The complaint to enforcement was regarding noise nuisance which was reported both on 19/9/23 & 2/4/24 by a resident. The clerk had received no further updates.

The Parish Council raised the importance of enforcement at West Berkshire Council to Cllr. Benneyworth as like many other parishes felt that there is no enforcement for these types of complaints. Cllr. Benneyworth reported that more resources are now being put in place.

# 16. BIODIVERSITY ENBORNE PROJECT (AgriSound) (SD)

Cllr. Dibas provided a presentation to propose that solar panelled devices are installed in the Parish to measure bee activities, making it easier to monitor bees which are in decline due to losing their habitat and the use of pesticides. The device is used to help protect bees and Enborne would be the first in West Berkshire in this initiative. It is used to find out if bees are declining or increasing, to then help find measures to protect bees to help biodiversity. Enborne Primary School has agreed to use the devices in their School where the pupils will be part of a school network, learning the importance of bees and their population.

The cost is £2,200 for three years, to provide 6 devices in the parish. Click <u>here</u> for more information on ArgiSound.

The parish council were all in favour and was resolved to buy six devices.

#### 17. ENBO/12/1 - AND OTHER PROW

This footpath refers to the pathway from Enborne Street to the Primary School. A WBC PROW officer was reported to visit site with a parish councillor to discuss what improvements are needed.
