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# MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF ENBORNE PARISH COUNCIL HELD AT 7.00 p.m. ON MONDAY, 16<sup>th</sup> JANUARY, 2017 IN THE BARN AT ST MICHAEL AND ALL ANGELS CHURCH, ENBORNE

(Please note: the meeting commenced at 7.20 pm due to the slight overrunning of the Poors Allotment meeting held prior to this meeting and to allow time for questions from residents and presentations by West Berkshire Councillors)

**PRESENT:** Cllrs J Leeson, A Croney, P Hart, M Darley and A Robinson.

#### 1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

1.1 There were no apologies for absence

#### 2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST AND DISPENSATIONS

- 2.1 Cllrs Leeson, Croney, Hart and Darley declared an interest in item 6 as Council taxpayers in the Parish.
- 2.2 There were no written requests for dispensations
- 2.3 Dispensations were granted to Cllrs Leeson, Croney, Hart and Darley for item 6.

#### 3. MINUTES OF THE LAST PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

3.1 The Parish Council **RESOLVED** to sign the minutes of the meeting of the Parish Council on 21st November, 2016 as a true record. The Chairman signed all pages of the loose leaf minutes.

#### 4. CLERK'S UPDATE

#### 4.1 Workplace Pensions

The Clerk reported that the declaration of compliance had been submitted to the Pensions Regulator on 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2016. This is the official record of what has been done to meet Enborne Parish Council's legal duties as an employer for automatic enrolment. Its receipt had been acknowledged.

#### 4.2 Parish Council Website

The Clerk reported that due to time constraints and pressure of work it had not been possible to progress the development of the website since the last meeting of the Parish Council

# 5. WEST BERKSHIRE COUNCIL – LIBRARY REVIEW

Details of the West Berkshire Council Library Review had been previously circulated in which West Berkshire Council had requested a contribution of £750 from Enborne Parish

Council towards library services. West Berkshire Council had not provided detailed information on how the money would be spent. NALC and BALC had advised that since Enborne Parish Council does not have the General Power of Competence it does not have the power to make the contribution. It was **RESOLVED** to inform West Berkshire Council that Enborne Parish Council would defer making a decision until 2018/19 when the West Berkshire Council position is clearer.

#### 6. PRECEPT

- 6.1 Review of current expenditure against budget.
- 6.1.1 A full bank reconciliation had been completed and circulated to members. There were no unpresented cheques. The balance in the accounts stood at £65,335.71 of which £53,278.24 is the remainder of the Waterman bequest.
- 6.1.2 The Clerk had previously circulated a paper giving details of expenditure against budget. Total expenditure to date was £7,857.62. Significant items of expenditure that are outstanding are the payment for the Vehicle Activated Signage Project in Enborne Row.
- 6.2 The Clerk had previously circulated a copy of the proposed budget for 2017/18. The proposal was discussed and other options considered. In accordance with Minute 12.2 of the November meeting of the Parish Council no increase in the Precept from 2016/17 was chosen as the preferred option. It was **RESOLVED** to request a precept of £14,200.

# 7. LETTER FROM THE INFORMATION COMMISSIONER

7.1 The Clerk gave a report on a letter dated 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2016, which had been received from the Information Commissioner. It was noted that Commission had found that Enborne Parish Council had breached the first data protection principle of the Data Protection Act which required the processing of personal data to be fair and lawful. The Commission had made a number of recommendations to improve the handling of personal data by Enborne Parish Council. It was **RESOLVED** to set up a working party of Cllr Hart and Cllr Robinson to review the recommendations and report back to the meeting in March 2017.

# 8. HOUSING SITE ALLOCATIONS DEVELOPMENT PLAN DOCUMENT

8.1 The Clerk had previously circulated information regarding the independent examination of the Housing Site Allocations Development Plan Document. Consultation on the Main Modifications proposed by the Planning Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State had started on 12<sup>th</sup> December, 2017. The deadline for submission of representations from Enborne Parish Council and any other interested parties was 5pm on Monday, 30<sup>th</sup> January, 2017. It was **RESOLVED** that the response from Enborne Parish Council should confirm previous responses and state that there were no new representations to be made.

#### 9. ROYAL BERKSHIRE FIRE AND RESCUE

9.1 Notification had been received from the Royal Berkshire Fire Authority that it is consulting with the public, its staff and other stakeholders on proposed changes to the way in which Royal Berkshire Fire and Rescue Services are delivered to residents. The Consultation closes on Monday, 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2017. Following representations from WBC Cllr Stansfeld it was **RESOLVED** to respond to the consultation suggesting that no changes are made to the Fire Authority until it is clear what the changes resulting from the Policing and Crime Bill which will allow local fire and rescue services and the police to engage in greater collaborative working will be.

# 10. WEST BERKSHIRE HOUSING AND ECONOMIC LAND AVAILABILITY ASSESSMENT (HELAA)

10.1 Enborne Parish Council had received a letter from West Berkshire Council with an invitation to submit potential development sites for them to consider as part of their HELAA. It was **RESOLVED** to set up a working party of Cllr Croney, Cllr Robinson and Cllr Darley to report back to the next meeting in March 2017 with suggestions for possible sites in Enborne Parish.

#### 11. WEST BERKSHIRE COUNCIL WEBSITE

11.1 Cllr Croney informed the meeting of problems he had experienced with the West Berkshire Council website. Members agreed these could potentially be solved by implementing software and systems used by other local authorities. It was **RESOLVED** to write to West Berkshire Council with suggestions for improvements to their website.

# 12. VEHICLE ACTIVATED SIGNAGE (VAS) PROJECT – ENBORNE ROW

12.1 The Chairman had previously reported as part of the discussions relating to the precept that the VAS project had not yet been completed (Minute 6.1.2 refers). It was noted that West Berkshire Council were currently investigating technical problems with connecting the system to the electrical supply. The Chairman agreed to contact the District Council for an update on progress.
